

Supplemental Order on Conditions of Bond: Firearms

The intent of the form is to create a system that gives defendants information about how to turn over firearms and also allows monitoring compliance of the defendant.

Directions:

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The form is to be used in conjunction with the typical bond form instructing the defendant from refraining from possessing a firearm.

Paragraph 2 instructs the defendant by which date and time and to which law enforcement department to the firearms should be turned over and date

Paragraph 3 instructs the defendant at date and time and where the FOID card be turned over.

Paragraph 4 instructs the Circuit Clerk's office to mail the FOID card to the Illinois State Police Firearms and Information Resources Bureau.

Paragraph 5 instructs the Circuit Clerk's office to notify the Court and State's Attorney's Office of compliance paragraphs 2 and 3

Paragraph 6 allows for a copy of a firearm dispositions report to be returned to the Clerk or the Court if the return or destruction of the firearm(s) occurs.

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The top portion of the page provides the law enforcement agency information that the defendant is required to surrender all firearms to the department, and it provides space for the officer to check the date and time of surrender or the lack of surrender.

The bottom portion of the page is to be filled out by the Circuit Clerk's Office and shows proof that the defendant did or did not surrender the FOID card.

A copy of this page should be entered in the court file.

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Attached to the form are sample Firearm/Weapons Inventory Receipt and Destruction or Release Receipt that can be used by law enforcement departments.
