

Rock Island County is located in the western portion of Illinois along the Mississippi River. Rock Island, the county seat, is a part of the Quad Cities, which also includes Moline, Illinois and Davenport and Bettendorf, Iowa. According to the US Census Bureau, the 2004 estimated population for Rock Island County was 160,141 with a land area of 458 square miles.

The Illinois site is located in Rock Island at the First Baptist Church, while the Iowa site is located in Davenport at the Newcomb Presbyterian Church. The churches alternate every other weekend. Each exchange center has two separate entrances and parking lots that are accessed by the custodial and non-custodial parents. Hours for the exchanges are Fridays from 5:30 p.m. to 6:15 p.m. and Sundays from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.. Families are assigned specific time slots for arrival and departure. Families may use either or both sites, depending on when their exchanges are scheduled. Weekday exchanges are available as well, and are facilitated in both the Moline and Davenport Bethany for Children and Families facilities.
